Terms ::

I advertise jobs via my website. I don't charge loads, but it brings in a bit extra and helps keep things running.

I do however have some "terms" which I adhere to regarding what I will and won't advertise.*

- "I won't advertise "cheap jobs". I'm keen to see salaried workers flourish in ministry, part of which is paying them properly . . . so, for example, a minimum stipend nationally for clergy is £23,800 (they also receive accommodation, have their council tax and water rates paid). So, for a full time post for a salaried worker I'm expecting a salary to be at least £25k IF it has an allowance for accommodation provided.
- A full time role needs to be around £30K.

E.G.

A city centre church offering £18,000 pro-rata for 20 hours a week (works out at about £750 take home) when to rent a two bedroom flat in the parish (not a four bedroom house with a study, which is what many clergy receive) is . . . £750. Well, that gives a total of NIL to live on.

I can't advertise that, sorry.
